associations - Reg

The heartburn caused to the Central Excise cadres in Kerala by the captioned notification that merges the existing Custom House, Cochin and Commissionerate of Customs (Preventive) Cochin and then bifurcating into North Kerala Customs Commissionerate and South Kerala Customs Commissionerate has already been brought to your notice by the separate representations of the individual associations. The issue has also been taken up with the Board.

2. The Co-coordinating committee meeting of the staff association of Kerala Central Excise Zone held on 07.09.2017 has unanimously decided to conduct a day long dharna at Central Excise Cochin, Calicut and Trivandrum Commissionerate Headquarters on 13.09.2017 in protest of the Board's action in disturbing the historical demarcation of customs jurisdiction in Kerala among the Central Excise & Customs cadres.

3. In the event of non maintenance of status quo till such time Board is bifurcated into Customs and Central tax, the co-ordination committee would be resorting to further agitation programmes. This is for your information
